Setting the standards

- ▶ Attendance – target 96.6% (Punctuality)
- ▶ School Uniform

Assessment and teaching arrangements

- ▶ Half termly Maths, Reading and Writing and half termly past SATs paper assessment tests for Y6
- ▶ Reading (bench marking half termly)
- ▶ Small group teaching / workshops
- ▶ Extra Maths and Literacy lessons after school later in year for Y6.
- ▶ Handwriting is very important in UKS2 and is assessed termly
- ▶ Library/parent volunteers boosting reading comprehension.

Curriculum

- ▶ Cross curricular topics will be set for this theme. (science/ history/geog/ pshe)

- ▶ They will sometimes get together for drama and role play activities.
