How will we keep you safe?

- You have the right to be kept safe from harm, at school and home.
- We try to provide a safe environment for you to learn in.
- We will do our best to ensure you remain safe.
- We think it is important for you to know where to get help, if you are worried or unhappy about something.
- If you need to talk, we will listen.
- It is wrong for anyone to hurt you, it is never your fault.

Telling somebody...

- Staff in school will listen to you and help you.
- They may write down what you have said.
- We will take what you say seriously.
- They may speak to your adult about it.





Who can I tell?

To get help you **must** tell somebody.

- If you are worried that you (or someone you know) is being hurt, it is important to tell someone you can trust.
- You can tell any adult at school
- We are trained to know how to help.

I should tell you if someone is...

- Bullying me
- Saying things to me that upset me or make me feel uncomfortable
- Touching me
- Hitting me or hurting me
- Taking my things
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to my phone
