

Walton Primary Academy – Early Years Foundation Stage – Medium Term Plan – Nursery - Autumn 2 2022

As communicators we will:

Develop our attention and listening skills in a variety of situations.

Respond to our names.

Build up our vocabulary (2/3 word level).

Express our needs and follow instructions.

Hold conversations with adults and our peers.

Join in with familiar rhymes and stories.

As individuals and friends we will:

Learn our friend's and adult's names.

Learn about the importance of sharing and taking turns.

Learn about right and wrong behaviours.

Begin to express own needs and wants.

As healthy movers we will:

Handle tools in the classroom safely.

Use the 'Funky Fingers' area to develop our fine motor skills.

Use the outdoor equipment to develop our gross motor skills.

Join in 'Squiggle While You Wiggle' and 'Dough Disco' to develop our gross motor and fine motor skills.

Begin to recognise the shapes of the letters in our name and copy a few of these.

Begin to use one handed tools and equipment.

Use scissors to snip.

Begin to negotiate space when moving. Be independent with our self-care – going to the toilet, washing our hands, putting our coats on.

Be able to access snack independently.

Be able to drink carefully without spilling.



As readers and writers we will:

Listen to a story at the end of every day.

Engage with books in the reading area – traditional tales/children's favourites.

Take part in daily phonics sessions.

Make a range of shapes and movements in writing.

Give meaning to the marks we make.

Listen and distinguish between environmental sounds, instrumental sounds.

Be able to make sounds with our bodies and identify body percussion sounds.

Join in with nursery rhymes, recognising the rhythm and rhyming words within.

As scientists, historians and geographers / explorers and investigators we will:

Explore painting and painting tools.

Recognise primary colours and some secondary colours.

Talk about present events.

Discover the changes that happen in Autumn.

Talk about our own environment.

Be able to identify an object by its function.

Know that there are different countries in the world.

To promote British Values we will:

Learn about mutual respect and tolerance.

We will learn to understand similarities and differences between each other.

As artists, actors and musicians we will:

Learn new songs, rhymes and dances.

Learn the names of basic instruments and learn how to play them correctly.

Explore colours.

As mathematicians:

Learn number rhymes.

Recite numbers from 0-5 in the correct order.

Sort objects into groups, by colour, size, shape etc.

Copy an AB pattern.

Listen to number stories.

Recognise 2D shapes and discuss some of their properties.

Begin to use vocabulary for example; big, little, more, heavy, lots, more, same.
